Global demand for skilled specialists – an introduction to “Training – Made in Germany”

iMOVE is an initiative of the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF) and a part of the international division at the Federal Institute for Vocational Education and Training (BIBB) in the Federal City of Bonn. Their objective is to promote international collaboration and the initiation of cooperation and business relationships in vocational training and continuing education.

Workshop Description

Ms. Schinkmann will introduce iMOVE and its services as well as the possibilities of cooperating with German training providers who are experts on work-based learning. A short introduction on the German dual system will be followed by examples of how some of the system's elements can support Emirati companies in developing the skills of their employees to meet high demand for high and constant quality and industry standards.

In discussion groups we will share experiences and talk about challenges as well as opportunities of German-Emirati-cooperation. Here, the focus is on how the “import” of German training services works and how it can be optimized to meet Emirati requirements better.
